The primary objective of this two day course is to assist with the appraisal and planning stages of an ECDIS passage plan as applied to the Strait of Malacca and Singapore Strait.

Producing a safe and effective berth to berth passage plan that accounts for all possibilities and eventualities requires skill and meticulous research. This is demanding enough when using paper charts but ECDIS brings new planning challenges that must be overcome to reduce navigational risk. This course will provide clarification on all aspects of ECDIS passage planning while highlighting recommended practices, common weaknesses and potential errors to help ensure that the skills required in passage planning are not negated when using ECDIS as a planning tool.

Successful completion of this course will result in the issue of an attendance certificate.
