The big change recently for the shipping industry has been the introduction of VSAT systems; the relatively cheap, effective satellite communication to shore. This means we are totally unprepared because for such a long time cyber security was not an issue at all for us. We need to wake up and fast. If you follow the 'hacking community' you can see that these people are very excited with the prospect of a new industry that they can take advantage of. They are becoming more and more knowledgeable on the ship system and see the shipping industry as, I quote, 'a low-hanging fruit' that they can grab easily because of the lack of cyber defence. Attacks could be focused on the control system of the ship, resulting in a danger to life or to the environment which is a really serious threat. There are already a few cases of these attacks so this is not just theoretical. This workbook is effective at dealing with these threats as it is very practical, there is not a lot of theory and it features checklists that you can follow in your day to day job for protecting the ship, making them easy to implement.'*
