Witherbys was among nine shortlisted businesses in the small business category (20-74 employees), and was given a podium finish in 3<sup>rd</sup> place. The award was given to the company at Scotland's Best Workplace award ceremony in Glasgow's Grand Central Hotel on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2013. Judges selected Witherbys for the award as they were impressed with the responses from the employees, who saw the company as having an open and approachable management style, a flat structure that led to better communications, felt involved with the business and its strategy and growth, trusted the directors and were proud of the work that the company's charitable trust is doing.

Managing Director Iain Macneil, who accepted the award, said *"It's a great to receive this award on behalf of the company. We believe that by creating a 'great place to work', our company is stronger and more successful. We all want to reach the company's goals and objectives together."*

The award contributes to a successful and exciting year for Witherbys. The company was recognised by the UK publishing industry when, in March, Witherbys were shortlisted for the Specialist Consumer Publisher of the Year award from the Independent Publishers Guild. Last month the company saw record sales of its latest edition of 'Passage Planning Guide – Malacca and Singapore Straits', a publication vital to many of the ships that use one of the busiest and congested seaways in the world.
